

Getting ready for the next phase

Since gaining planning approval, we've been busy behind the scenes progressing the design and technical details. It's all part of keeping things moving, so we can get the next phase of development underway as soon as possible.

The aim is to start on site by the end of the year or early next- an exciting step, which will bring to life the new affordable homes and community facilities you've told us you want and need.

We're also speaking with business owners in Aberfeldy Street about ways to minimise disruption to their trade as the development moves forward. These conversations are focused on exploring nearby temporary relocation options that work for them and help keep their businesses thriving.

Of course, we know construction can cause some disruption. A construction partner will be appointed soon, and once in place, we'll share more about how they'll be working to keep things running as smoothly as possible for everyone.

There's a lot to look forward to, and we can't wait to get started.

Building phases

We understand it's important for you to know when building work will start and when you can expect to move into your new home.

While we can't confirm definite dates yet, here's an estimated time-scale for each building phase.



Phase 4A

Blairgowrie House, Aberfeldy Street, Existing community centre

Startonsite-Winter 2025 / Spring 2026, Completion-Q12029

Phase 4B

Nairn Street blocks, Abbott Road blocks, Leven Road blocks

Start on site - Autumn 2028 Completion - Spring 2033


Phase 4C and D

Heather House, Tartan House, Thistle House, Kilbrennan House, Balmore Close, Findhorne Street, Jura House

Start on site - Autumn 2033 Completion - Winter 2037*

"Really hoping for more local shops."


"It'll be great to have safer, cleaner streets to walk around."
