## WHAT'S NEXT, AFTER PLANS TO TRANSFORM ABERFELDY VOTED **DOWN BY COUNCILLORS?**

With 93% of the community voting YES to regeneration and over 1000 letters of support received, echoing the views of people throughout our consultation in and beyond

Aberfeldy, the whole community were hopeful their elected representatives would agree to these life changing proposals when they went to committee.



## What has happened?

At February's meeting of Tower Hamlets Council's Strategic Development Committee, the Aberfeldy planning application was refused, despite being recommended for approval by council officers. We share your disappointment, as we know there was clear community support for our plans to deliver new affordable homes, green spaces and community facilities.

## What now?

The Mayor of London, Sadiq Khan has reviewed the council's decision and has agreed that the application should be looked at again.

The Mayor has decided to 'call in' the application. This means he has stepped in to take control of the application from Tower Hamlets Council.

The Mayor will now review the application and weigh up all information and opinions, before making a decision at a public hearing, hopefully later this year. Your support is more important than ever.
