New GP, café, grocery shop & town square open this year



Your future Aberfeldy

The latest phase of the redevelopment will complete soon with your new GP practice, café, grocery shop, restaurant, pharmacy and a new town square expected to open by the end of this year.

A planning application is currently being considered by Tower Hamlets Council for an ambitious new masterplan for the next phase of the redevelopment. The plan proposes over 1,500 new homes, shops, workspaces and public realm centred around health and wellbeing.

Aberfeldy GP Practice

From winter, the Aberfeldy Health and Wellbeing Centre will be the new home for the Aberfeldy Practice offering GP services together with NHS specialist clinics and community wellness sessions in partnership with Poplar HARCA.



Aberfeldy Café

A new wellness café bringing everyone together to enjoy healthy, tasty food, with a meeting space and internal access to the new GP practice.



Grocery Store

Deli/restaurant

A new, sit in restaurant which may be owned

by local residents and offer a deli counter.

A new grocery shop where everyone will be able to buy fresh food and every day household favourites



Pharmacy

A new local health care space to pick up prescriptions and receive every day health care support.





Aberfeldy Square

Your new public square will open, connecting green space, local amenities, all in one vibrant and convenient place.

Your favourite Aberfeldy Street businesses will stay open from spring 2023, moving to Jura House while development at Aberfeldy Street takes place.

Poplar Green Futures is a project bringing together local residents, business owners and organisations to explore ideas and priorities for a greener, low carbon future for Poplar.



Residents move in to new affordable homes for rent in Aberfeldy Village

The new homes, a mix of 1-4 bedroom apartments and maisonettes, marks a total of 39 new homes for affordable rent completed in Aberfeldy, this year.

Lutfur Rahman, Mayor of Tower Hamlets and Councillor Kabir Ahmed, Cabinet Member for Regeneration, were warmly welcomed by the new residents when they visited Aberfeldy to celebrate the handover of the new homes, in June.

Mohamed Hassan, a Tower Hamlets resident of 24 years, previously lived in a bedsit on the neighbouring Teviot estate. Mr Hassan said:

"I went to have a look at my new flat and loved it straight away. I want to stay living here for a long time. It's very spacious and on the ground floor which is better for me because I have a medical condition which makes using stairs difficult.

I have a separate bedroom and a patio, so I can sit outside and living in a bigger property, I don't have to cram my belongings in anymore.

My niece happens to live in Aberfeldy Village too, so it's great to have my family close by."

More new homes on the horizon

We recently celebrated the topping out of the first 219 affordable homes at Poplar Riverside, a major new waterside neighbourhood on the banks on the River Lea.

Joined by Aberfeldy residents Sada and Shukri, the event was hosted by developer St William.

The first residents are expected to move into their new homes in summer or autumn 2023. The affordable homes will form a key part of the first phase of the development, which in total will deliver 643

homes across four buildings. Of the affordable new homes 123 will be for affordable rent and 96 will be shared ownership properties.

A significant new chapter for this part of the capital, Poplar Riverside is one of east London's most exciting regeneration projects, providing more than 2,800 new homes.

Update on regeneration

We are excited to share with you that the masterplan application is due to be heard by Tower Hamlets councillors this autumn.

This is an important milestone in the regeneration of Aberfeldy, and we will update you once a decision has been made.

As a reminder, the masterplan will:

Deliver 1,628 new high-quality homes, 35% of which will be affordable overall and 47% of these delivered within in the first phase.

- Breathe new life into Aberfeldy Street with shops, community space and a new town square.
- Expand on the success of Poplar Works on Nairn Street, through the provision of affordable workspace aimed at keeping local businesses in the area.
- Create new and improved green open spaces.
- Repurpose the existing A12 vehicle underpass into a new east-west walking and cycling route.
- Create a new vehicle junction on the A12 for residents.

Aberfeldy Stories 10 year celebration brings community together




A massive thank you
