Residents get exclusive first look

Members of the Resident Steering Group were given an exclusive preview of the eagerly awaited new community centre, cafe and health and wellbeing centre in Aberfeldy Square, before their doors open this spring.

A total of seven new services will open in Aberfeldy Square in 2023. As well as a new, bigger community centre, wellness café and health and wellbeing centre, the Co-op, a pharmacy, nursery, and deli restaurant, will also open by summer.

Alaina Morshead, who as part of the Aberfeldy Resident Steering Group has played a key role in developing future regeneration plans, said:

"The tour of the new centres reminds us how much better Aberfeldy has already become because of regeneration. I can't wait for the regeneration to continue. It's a wonderful opportunity to make sure our community continues to thrive and for Aberfeldy to become the place to be in east London."

A planning decision from Tower Hamlets Council on the Aberfeldy New Masterplan is expected in February. The new masterplan includes 440 new affordable homes as well as green spaces and children's play spaces, and improvements to Millenium Green, Leven Road and Braithwaite Park.


