WE DID IT!

Local community group Fit and Feisty improve public access to Teviot Centre





TEVIOT CENTRE



A go-getting community group has made access to the Teviot community centre safer and easier for everyone.

Recently formed local group, Fit and Feisty, are behind a new drop kerb, road markings and new parking restrictions, which have improved public access to the Teviot Centre.

The new drop kerb means wheelchair and mobility scooter users and those with pushchairs now have a quicker, safer route. Road markings and new parking restrictions prioritise the space at the front of the centre for those who need it.

'We only had one drop kerb outside the centre. Those who struggle with mobility had to walk right to the end of the street, and cross over to get in. We wanted to make things easier for them.'



'The changes have a big impact, it's now much safer for everyone coming to the centre.'

Fit and Feisty is for local people aged 50 years plus, and was set up in the pandemic to help reduce isolation, through socialising and getting active.

A Teviot resident of 40 years said about the group: 'The group helps me enjoy life and improve my wellbeing. Our fitness instructor Victor has been an inspiration and gives me a good boost.'

Reduced the 25-storey building to 8-storeys

What you said...

We want less height adjacent to St Michaels Court area in South Teviot **⋖** What we did...

Reduced the height and scale of the blocks adjacent to St Michael's Court to 3-storeys

○ What you said...

We want more height along the A12 to reduce the overall masterplan heights and create more open space Positioned extra height by the A12, reduced some of the building heights, and created a new spacious park in north Teviot

What you said...

We want more family houses

♂ What we did...

Created additional houses adjacent to St Michaels Court and on the existing shop site in north Teviot

What you said...

We want more 2-bedroom houses

♂ What we did...

Changed some of the 3-bedroom houses along Dewberry Street to 2-bedroom houses offering a greater variety of homes for existing residents What you said...

We want a safer Langdon Park

⋖ What we did...

Optimised the amount of ground level activity and windows overlooking the park. Held park consultations with residents and the borough's Parks team to generate landscape ideas. Held Light Follows Behaviour RSG workshop to run through exciting lighting options.

○ What you said...

We want to ensure podiums are safe, resident controlled and low maintenance **⋖** What we did...

Revised the residential podium blocks to create fully enclosed courtyards with dedicated resident entrances. Refined the landscape proposals to optimise quality whilst minimising maintenance.

What you said...

We want the phase 1 buildings to be even more reflective of Teviot's uniqueness **♂** What we did...

Continued to enhance the quality of the phase 1 designs to respond to the rich character of St Michaels Court, Langdon Park School and Radford House whilst shaping bold, modern park side buildings that would be spacious & attractive to live in.



Our Next Steps

We are delighted that over the past six years we have spoken to over 1,000 Teviot residents of all ages, experiences, and backgrounds. We've spoken in sitting rooms, on doorsteps, at school gates, in meetings, at community events, drop-ins, festivals, on WhatsApp and by phone.

It's been a privilege to speak to so many local people about our masterplan and hear their views on the future of our area.

We are currently reviewing the masterplan to update it to meet the Government's latest fire safety design requirements, and aim to submit a formal planning application to the Council this summer.

Light Follows Behaviour Tour

Back in January, members of the Residents Steering Group took part in a tour of Teviot estate looking at how they could improve the lighting.

Residents were introduced to different types of lighting that could be used in the communal areas throughout the estate.

During the tour, various issues were raised regarding the quality and appropriateness of the existing lighting. Residents suggested that more energy efficient LED lighting should be installed, in order to reduce energy consumption as

well as provide more safety during hours of darkness. They also felt that better placement of lights was necessary to improve visibility for pedestrians.

The Steering Group was then taken to different areas where potential new lighting could be installed, including Courtyard spaces, underpasses, entrance to Teviot, Silver Bridge and Langdon Park.

Residents gave feedback on which fittings they would prefer and how much light each area should have. They also looked into how



motion sensor technology could be implemented to limit unnecessary electricity consumption during offpeak times.

After a vote, residents decided on improving the communal underpasses for now and will take part in further workshops to help with the design of the new lighting.

The new lights are intended to create a safer and more pleasant environment for residents. It is hoped that this small step will make a big difference to how people use the estate while we wait for construction work to begin.



Poplar Works Birthday

Poplar Works celebrated its 3rd birthday this month. Over 60 people attended daytime activities including workshops, open studio tours and pop-up shops, while 40 people attended an evening celebration. There was a good mix of local residents, people interested in fashion, fashion businesses and community stakeholders.

Poplar Works has done really well over its first 3 years. Currently:

- 95% of the workspaces are occupied, half of which are by businesses from the local area
- 556 participants have taken part in community programmes
- Through the Making for Change programme, 37 people have completed a Level 1 qualification in Fashion and Textiles
 Production, and 18 of these have completed Level 2. At least 2 people from each secure employment in the Making for Change production unit on site.

Mould and condensation


Keep an eye out for condensation even as we head in to the warmer months. Remember a build-up of condensation can cause mould.
