**Chrisp St Planning**

We were delighted that the Chrisp St planning application had been approved by the Strategic Development Committee and congratulated staff, partners and residents for their hard work in getting the application through.

**Teviot Estate Regeneration: Resident Involvement**

We noted the work undertaken so far on engaging Teviot residents in developing proposals for the regeneration of their estate.

We were pleased with the progress to date and the methods used to engage residents to date. We noted that leaseholders' votes will now contribute to the ballot result and that their engagement has been positive so far. We also noted that freeholders have also been involved in the resident steering group.

**Performance**
